
## How to use your love egg

- Twist the egg anticlockwise to unscrew. Insert the 2 x N batteries, following the diagram printed on the compartment and twist back together.
- Press and push down on the back of the remote to remove the battery cover. Insert the A23 battery, positive-side facing down. Replace the battery cover.
- Click the power button on the remote to start the vibrations. Use the function button to move through the 3 speeds and 7 vibration patterns.
- Click the power button on the remote to switch off. Clean your love egg with sex toy cleaner and leave to dry until next time.
- Use with plenty of water-based lubricant for maximum enjoyment.
- You MUST remove the batteries from the egg after use and store separately. Leaving the batteries in this toy will cause the batteries to drain quickly.
